Narrator: Listening Test

Slogan Competition

Section 2

You will hear two children calling the radio station with ideas for the slogan competition.

The recording will be played twice. Do as much as you can the first time and answer all the questions the second time.

You have 30 seconds to look at your questions.

[30 sec music]

Listen and answer the questions.

{[telephone ringing]}

Telephonist: Thank you for calling Radio Kidz. My name is Cindy. How can I help you?

Michelle: Hello. I'm calling about the pet store slogan competition.

Telephonist: Excellent. Before you tell us your idea, I need to take your name and address in case we need to contact you.

Michelle: Of course.

Telephonist: Lovely. What's your name?

Michelle: Michelle Wu.

Telephonist: Thank you, Michelle. And could you tell me your address?

Michelle: Yes, it's Flat thirteen.

Telephonist: Thirteen?

Michelle: That's right. Twelfth Floor, Oak Building. *(pause)* One hundred and nineteen Beech Street.

Telephonist: *(copying the address and repeating it slowly)* One hundred and nineteen Beech Street.

Michelle: Tai Po.

Telephonist: That's marvellous, Michelle. And what is your slogan?

Michelle: My slogan is "Furry Family Friends for all the Family"

Telephonist: *(copying the address and repeating it slowly)* "Furry Family Friends for all the Family"... I like it.

Michelle: Thank you.

Telephonist: We will announce the winners on the radio next Saturday. If you have won, we will contact you. Thanks for calling, goodbye.

Michelle: Thank you and bye.

[dead phone tone]
[telephone ringing again]

Telephonist: Thank you for calling Radio Kidz. My name is Cindy. How can I help you?

Ronnie: I've got an idea for the pet slogan competition.

Telephonist: That's great. Do you mind if I take your details first in case we need to contact you?

Ronnie: Not at all.

Telephonist: Thanks. Your full name first please.

Ronnie: Ronnie Wong.

Telephonist: And your address?

Ronnie: *[slowly]* Flat fifteen, Seventh Floor, Plain Building, One forty four Ash Road, Kwun Tong.

Telephonist: Got it. Thanks, Ronnie. And what's your slogan idea?

Ronnie: *[slowly]* "If it buzzes or miaows, we've got it!"

TAPESCRIPT

Telephonist: Let me write that down... *(read it out slowly)* "If it buzzes or miaows, we've got it". It's a very nice slogan, Ronnie. Thanks for calling, goodbye.

Ronnie: Thanks, goodbye.}

Narrator: Now listen to the recording again.

[repeat recording {}]

You have 30 seconds to check your answers.
