- Note that the possible language structures, expressions, and vocabulary given below are not exhaustive lists. They are guides to show teachers some of the possible structures, expressions, and words students may choose to use

Possible language structures and expressions:

1. Referring to events

“I have been playing for three years ...”

“I used to go to ...”

“I would like to ...”

“I practise three times a week ...”

“I sometimes ...”

2. Justifying a point of view

“... is good exercise”

“... although it is ...”

“I would rather ...”

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“... is my favourite pastime, since ...”

“On the other hand, ...”

“Some people think ... ; however, ...”

3. Describing feelings and responses

“... makes me feel happy”

“... enjoyable and relaxing”

“... is my favourite thing ...”

“I absolutely love ...”

“I’m passionate about ...”

“... is absorbing ...”
