You and your friend are going to have a meal at a restaurant this evening. Look at the menu and decide what you will order. Tell your teacher what food you have chosen and why.




Prepare a two-minute presentation about the topic. You can use <u>some ideas</u> from the following and/or your own ideas in your presentation.
